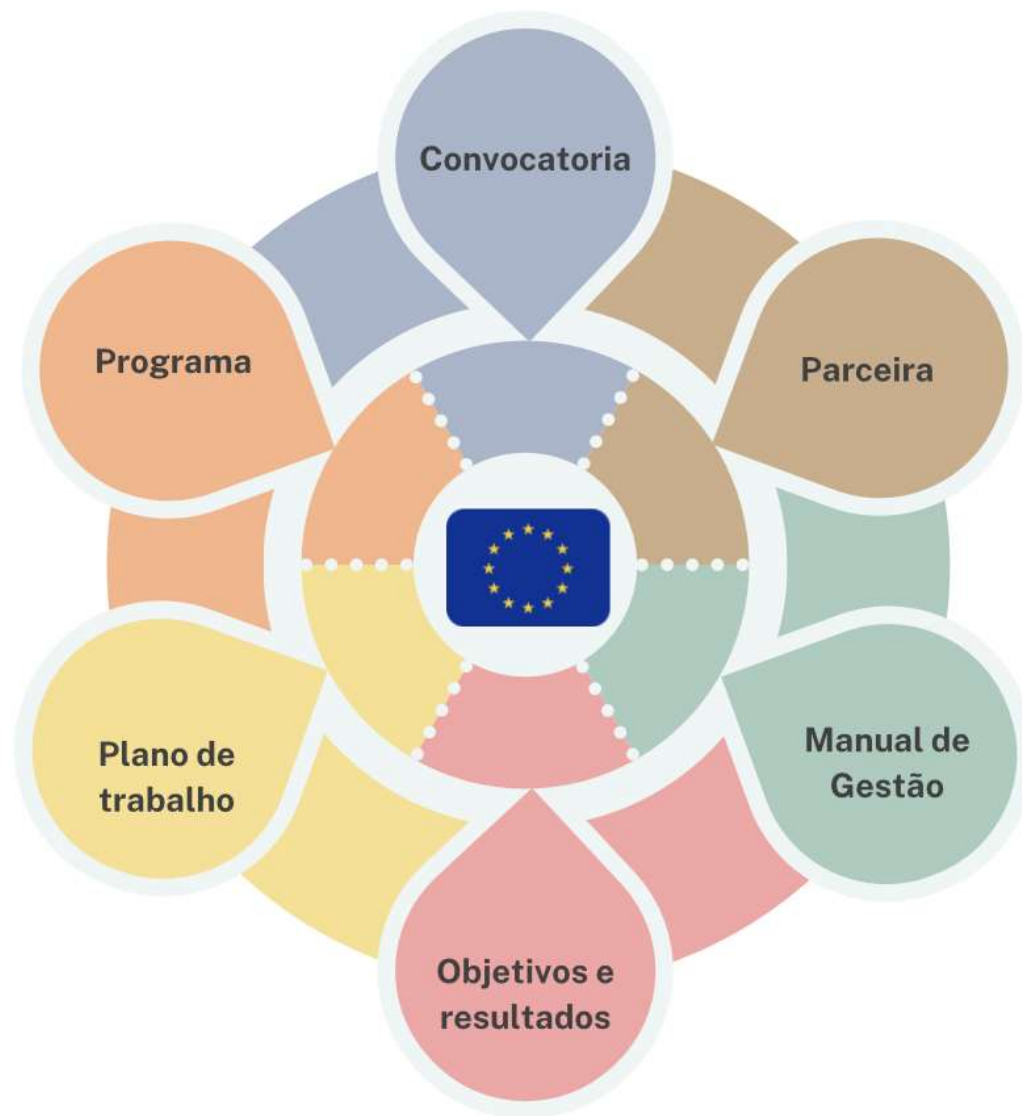
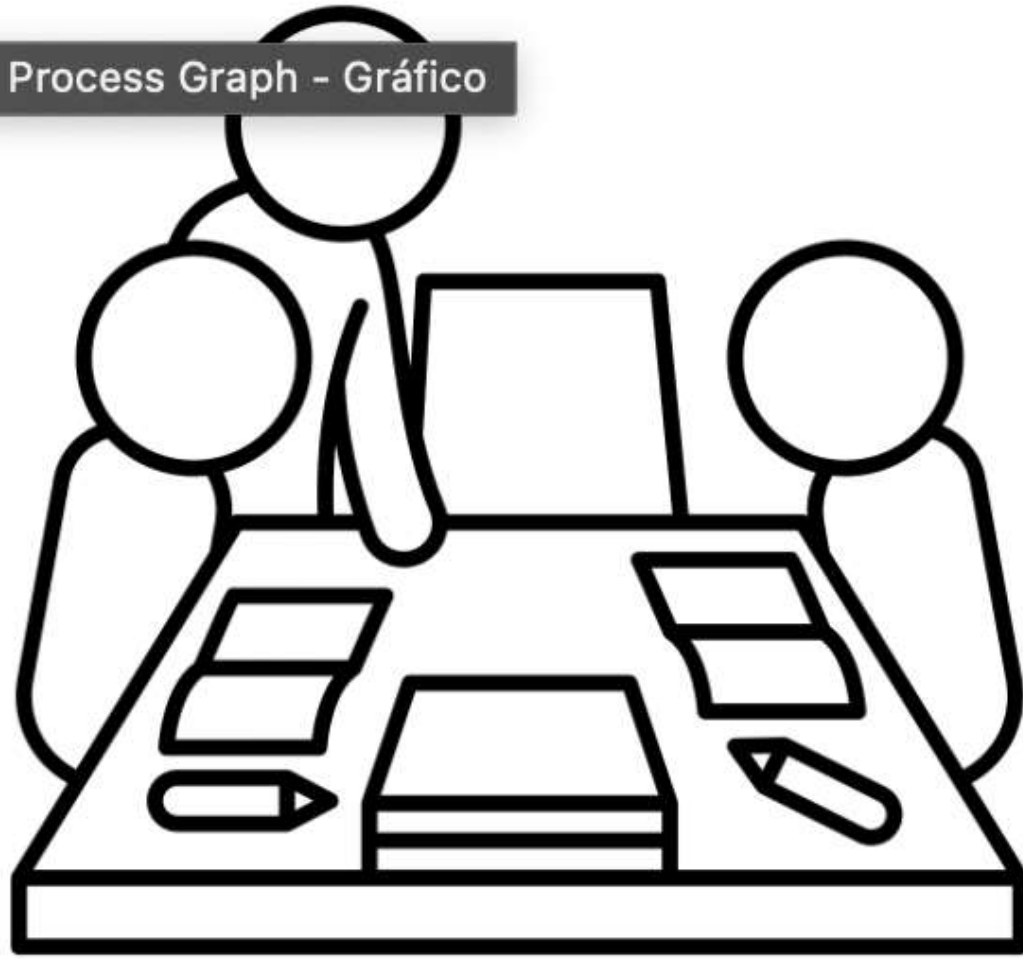

O programa LIFE é o instrumento financeiro da UE que apoia projetos no domínio do ambiente, da conservação da natureza e da ação climática. Visa fazer face a alguns desafios urbanos, como a qualidade do ar, o ruído, a energia e os resíduos. O orçamento total para o financiamento de projetos entre 2014 e 2020 é de 1,1 mil milhões de euros para projetos no domínio do ambiente e de 0,36 mil milhões de euros para projetos relacionados com a ação climática.

Summary

R-EU-FTOP gathers 9 European cities & independent cultural operators exploring how to make use of the underused 15-35% of Europe's urban landscape: the roofscape. Roofscape means the (tangible) landscape built heritage formed by the roofs of buildings, as well as the scene or view of/from roofs, considered in terms of its aesthetic and (intangible) cultural meanings. The R-EU-FTOP vision is to imagine, create and share new uses for Europe's roofscape: as cultural heritage & venues, open community spaces; creative labs for climate adaptation, re-industrialization, circular economy; this applied in the objectives: to develop urban rooftops as accessible community spaces across Europe; as cultural spaces and artistic/creative media; to pilot creative rooftop-projects with focus on social, economic, environmental sustainability; to establish a European-wide network of roofscape festivals and practitioners; to develop a transnational roadmap & action plan for the "Roofscape Europe" movement; to spread tools and methods into new locations. R-EU-FTOP also fosters the work of cultural and creative agents, by supporting creation, production and mobility. During 2020-2024, outputs are 9 roofscape heritage mapping + future roofscape visions at city level, 9 transnational artistic residencies engaging 18+ artists, 18+ original roofscape artworks/projects (4 of them by globally-renowned European artists), + 54 associated roofscape activities in the form of creative courses & workshops, cultural events, local guided tours. With a perspective from above, R-EU-FTOP creates new horizons for Europe, providing citizens with the opportunity to re-discover and re-use their roofscape heritage to improve the creativity, livability and sustainability of their cities. It nurtures among citizens a shared "sense of European place", by connecting cross-border cultural experiences and future visions of rooftops in a joint European narrative for a more creative and sustainable Europe.

Alterações Climáticas

As **zonas urbanas** encontram-se fortemente vulneráveis aos impactes provenientes das **alterações climáticas**, tais como aumento da temperatura, subida do nível médio do mar, precipitação excessiva, ocorrência de inundações, deslizamentos de terras, diminuição da qualidade do ar, escassez de água, problemas ao nível do abastecimento, ocorrência de incêndios florestais, entre outros, tornando-se estes impactes ainda mais intensos quando afetam os serviços públicos, infraestruturas e ainda o setor habitacional.

O projeto Life Adaptate será implementado em seis municípios de três países europeus: **Espanha, Portugal e Letónia.**



O projeto Life Adaptate será implementado em seis municípios de três países europeus: **Espanha, Portugal e Letónia.**



Solução proposta: São acções-piloto do município da Alfândega da Fé:

1. Implementar um lago natural de modo a responder à grande vulnerabilidade do município aos fenómenos da seca e consequente risco de incêndio.
2. Criar zona de sombra com a integração de energias renováveis com uma área total de aproximadamente 120,00 m2.
3. Promoção de projetos para a criação de uma floresta multifuncional com base em espécies endógenas e promoção da regeneração natural dessas mesmas espécies.



Solução proposta: A acção-piloto é o resultado de um conjunto de iniciativas que promovem a mitigação das altas temperaturas nas horas de maior insolação diária, favorecendo a infiltração da água em episódios de chuva e a fixação do CO2 através da vegetação. A criação de espaços sombreados será feita com a introdução de espécies arbóreas nativas e autóctones bem adaptadas, com a expansão dos canteiros de árvores, introduzindo pérgolas, sendo algumas destas com coberturas verdes, no mobiliário urbano, utilizando as mesmas espécies trepadeiras e ainda com a construção de bancos para descanso dos utilizadores da zona.

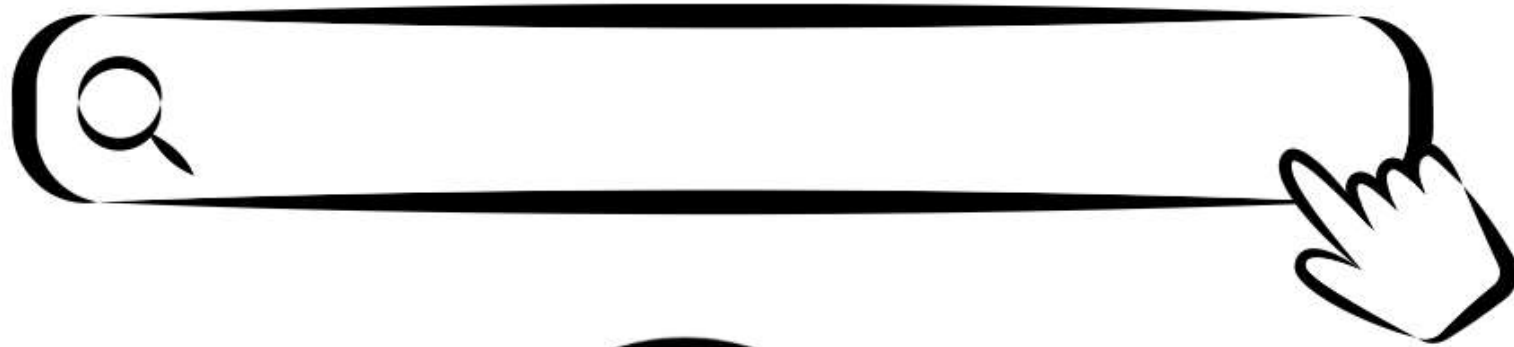

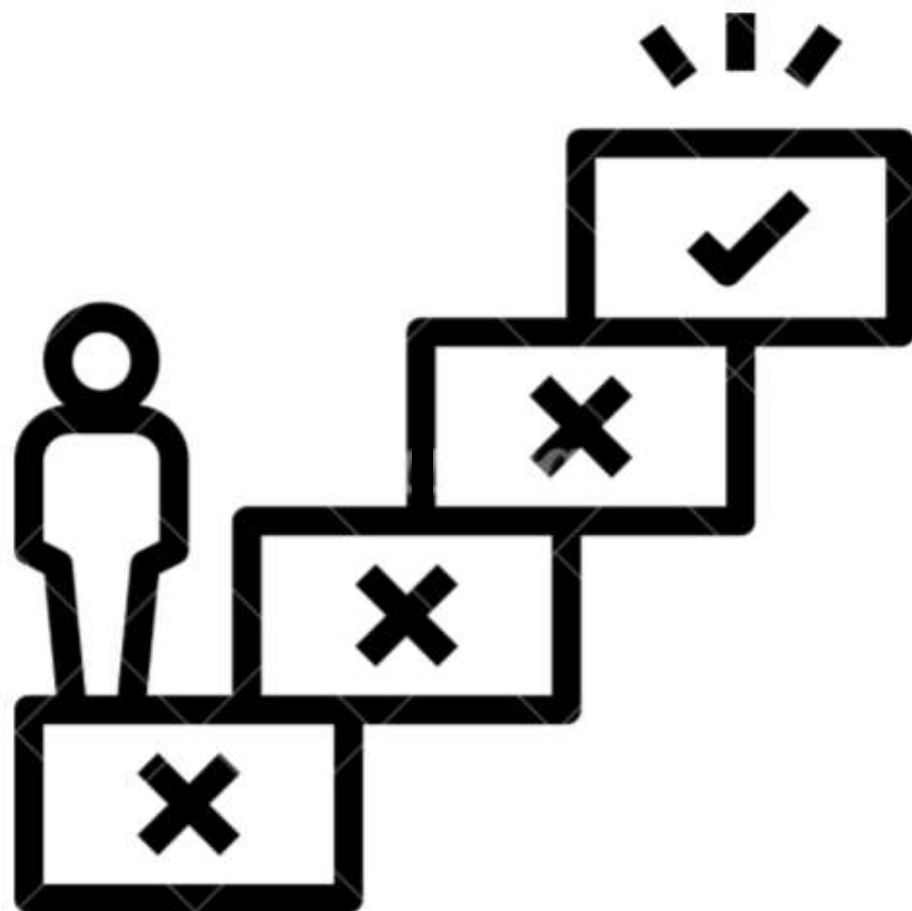
